The University of Camerino, established in 1336, is one of the oldest universities in Italy and assures its students high academic quality, high quality of life and technologically advanced services in harmony with nature.

The scholarships can only be used for courses offered in the months of **June through November 2018**. Winning students are strongly encouraged to enroll 40-60 days in advance of the month they wish to attend as space is limited.
