COURSE DESCRIPTION: This is an intermediate level course that is conducted entirely in Italian and geared towards motivated high school students who wish to take the **SAT® Subject Test in Italian** in December 2015. The objective of the course is to review basic grammatical structures and vocabulary, and improve your understanding of content from authentic sources such as newspaper and magazine articles, fiction, historical works, advertisements, tickets, brochures, forms and schedules. Students must be heritage speakers of Italian or they must have completed at least two years of Italian in high school or the equivalent.

This course is highly recommended for students who are planning to register in our Advanced Italian Language and Culture course beginning in January 2016.

HOMEWORK - WEEKLY ASSIGNMENTS: Please be aware that I will assign homework weekly. Our lessons will not be effective unless you complete the assigned work in-between lessons. It is recommended that you devote at least 2 hours each week to review the material and complete the assigned homework.

WORKBOOK – CLASS MATERIAL:

We will use **Schoology** to post and submit homework assignments, to share any additional course material and to communicate about the course. If you have not used Schoology before, please create a free student account on www.schoology.com before the beginning of the course. We will e-mail you individually the access code to join our class.

COURSE COMPLETION AND GRADING: Upon completion of the course, students can request a certificate of completion including the grade obtained.

Your grade will be calculated as follows:
50% Final exam
30% homework
20% Class Participation

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This is an intermediate-to-pre-advanced level course that is conducted entirely in Italian and geared towards motivated high school students who are planning to take the AP[®] Italian exam in May 2016.

- Students will meet for two hours once a week for fifteen weeks in a virtual classroom together with other students and an ICoN-certified instructor. (We will use www.gotomeeting.com.)
- Students will complete the College Board approved ICoN AP[®] online Italian Language and Culture course under the guidance of the instructor.
- Students will learn to master authentic material, explore the six themes required by the College Board.
- Students will become familiar with the exam structure and take practice tests.
- The instructor will assign and review homework, give direction and suggestions, and provide explanations and ongoing support to the students.

HOMEWORK - WEEKLY ASSIGNMENTS: Please be aware that I will assign homework weekly. Our lessons will not be effective unless you work on the ICoN online course outside of class. It is recommended that you devote at least 3 hours each week to review the material and complete the assigned homework.
